Stepping Forward for Mental Health — The Inasmuch Foundation

St. Anthony Hospital is dedicated to healing the mind, body and spirit - and is the state's first and largest provider of behavioral medicine offering 272 patient beds.

The St. Anthony Behavioral Medicine Center, located on the St. Anthony Medical Campus, received a \$250,000 grant from the Inasmuch Foundation to support interior renovations to the Center.

Oklahoma has the highest rate of severe mental illness in the nation, with one in three Oklahoman's suffering from some level of mental illness. Tammy Powell, COO for St. Anthony Hospital comments, "Mental illness is a pervasive, destructive, health problem-affecting children, adolescents and adults. On a daily basis, we treat the mental health issues of more than 120 children and adolescent patients at the Center and estimate that 75% of these patients have been victimized physically, mentally and/or sexually. In many cases, this is their first experience in a safe, caring environment."

The Center will be completely renovated at an estimated cost of \$9 million - \$7.5 million financed from capital bonds and the Foundation is seeking \$1.5 million from philanthropic gifts. Dr. Brent Bell, Department Chair for Psychiatry at St. Anthony explains, "The importance of a safe, yet warm and comforting environment is essential in each patient's care plan - especially for some of our children and adolescents that may have extended stays." The renovation will include patient bedrooms, bathrooms, living areas, school classrooms and exercise areas.

"Mental illness is a serious problem in Oklahoma, and the Inasmuch Foundation is honored to be part of the continuation of quality health care for patients at the St. Anthony Behavioral Medicine Center," said Inasmuch Foundation President and CEO Bob Ross.

Fred's Legacy



One of the first gifts ever received by St. Anthony Hospital was a horse named Fred. But wait! Before you rush to give us your prize winning thoroughbred, think about other "noncash gifts."

What's a noncash gift?

A noncash gift is a donation made to the Foundation which is sold or redeemed to benefit the programs and healthcare

services of the Hospital. A noncash gift can be antique furnishings; artwork; real estate; mineral interests; airline miles; hotel loyalty points; livestock; stocks, bonds and other securities; and/or intellectual properties, such as patents and copyrights.

And the most popular noncash gift is?

Corporate stock! An appreciated stock, when sold, is

subject to the capital gains tax. When you donate that stock to St. Anthony Foundation, however, you avoid the capital gains tax and you can take the full fair-market value of the stock as a charitable deduction.

Here's a trend!

The donation of closely held stock is another way for St. Anthony Foundation to benefit from a noncash gift. By donating shares of closely held stock, the Foundation may then present the stock to your company for redemption. The benefit of this arrangement is that retained earnings held in the company can finance the redemption of the stock. These retained earnings have already been taxed at a corporate rate, so rather than the company distributing the earning through dividends (which are further taxed as dividend income) you can finance the redemption of the stock held by the Foundation.
